

From Your Print Chairman

The Count Down Is On!

Hello everyone. Well our convention and print competition is only a few weeks away. The list is out! We have six judges...Pat Hanson, Gene Lista, Rich Martin, Tony Christiana (SEPPA President), Ester and Rich Beitzel. Three of these folks are PPA affiliated judges. All of them will stay after the competition to discuss your prints.

The DPP board did not raise the print case price so it remains at \$35.00 per case – to include 6 prints (no more than 4 in one category) 2 album, and 2 folios (6 to 8 original prints in an <u>un-retouched</u> original digital files, or film, form a single session, in a tri fold or double folio).

The Competition will be held this year -please note- Caesar's Hotel, Atlantic City -- NOT MODERN MATURITY/or The Dover Sheraton as in previous years. There will be no late excuses for going to the wrong place.

One change from last month!!! Prints cases will be accepted Sunday February 26, 2006 from Noon to 1:00PM in the Spartacus and Tiberius Rooms. No exceptions! There will be directions to the print competition in the main ballroom of Caesar's.

Judging will begin promptly at 1:30 PM and continue until the closed door session when the committee will present the judges with the prints to be chosen for all the awards for DPP, Kodak, and Fuji. We are adding a new one for this year, Jonathan Penney of Jonathan Penny Master Print Maker is sponsoring a "Bests B/W Photo of the year"

After the closed door session we will then photograph the prints and put them on display till Monday evening, at which time you may pick them, up or make arrangements to have them picked. The print committee WILL NOT be responsible for prints left in the room at the end of this convention competition.

This year every print that has scored 80 or better is eligible for a Kodak Gallery Award or a Fuji masterpiece award. One or the other, a single print will NOT receive both

DPP presents over 25 awards at the banquet – you can be among the winners – and as the saying goes –"you have to enter to win".
