Directions:

FROM NORTH:

Take Rt.1 South to the South Smyrna exit.

This will be obvious that you will be passing over/around Smyrna.

RIGHT at the exit onto NORTH 13, you will drive less than a mile northward and turn RIGHT onto Smyrna-Leipsic Rd. This road leads to Bombay Hook, too.

**** Young's property is exactly 1/2 mile down and on the Right, the only home with a large white fence.**

FROM SOUTH:

Take Rt.1 North exactly as described above.

This is approximately 7-8 miles north, past, the familiar Dover Sheraton.

If on Rt. 13 instead, simply also turn RIGHT at the road described above.

FROM EAST:

Wipe your muddy feet, shake the cat-tails offn' ya and ask someone!
